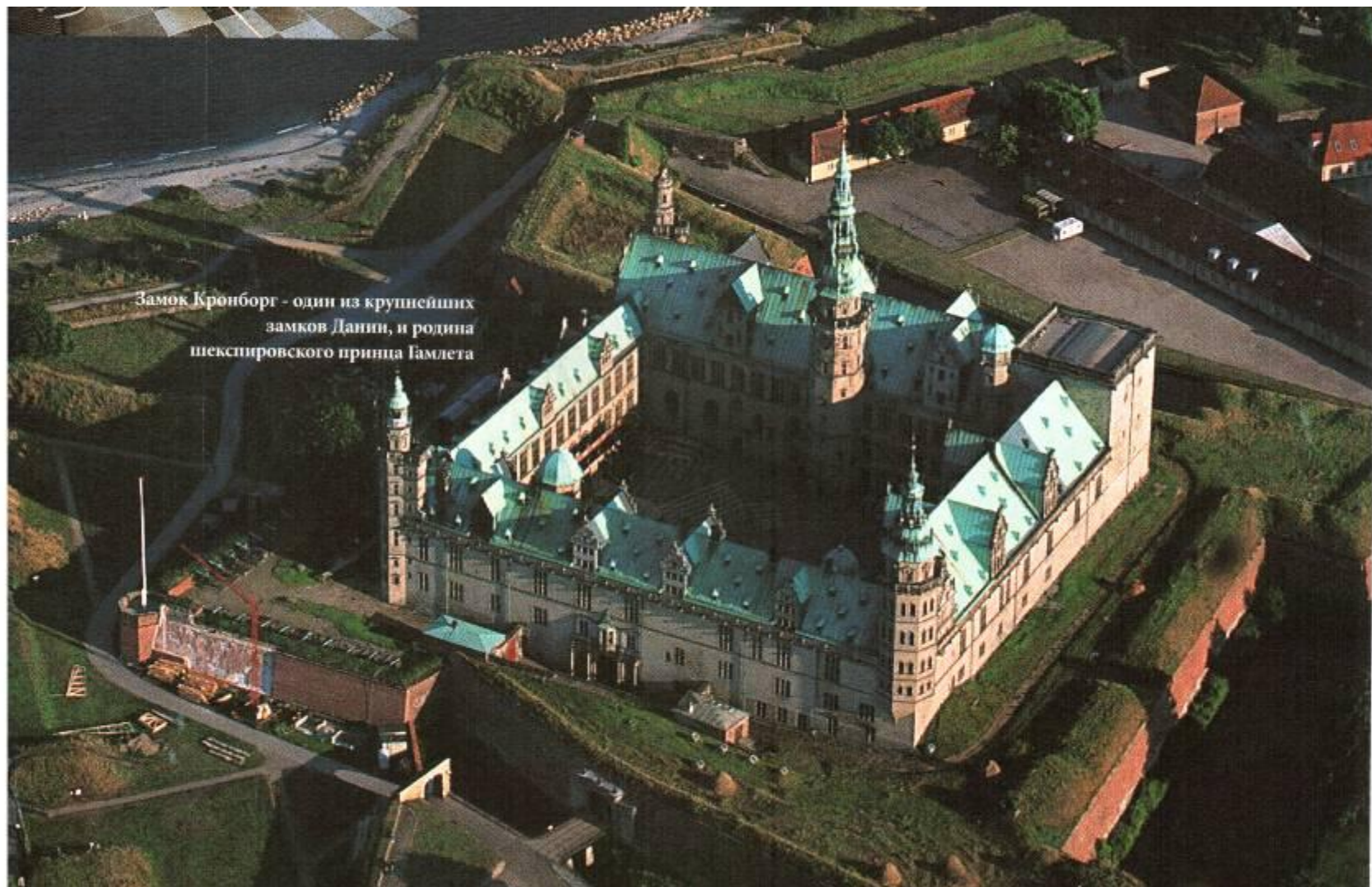

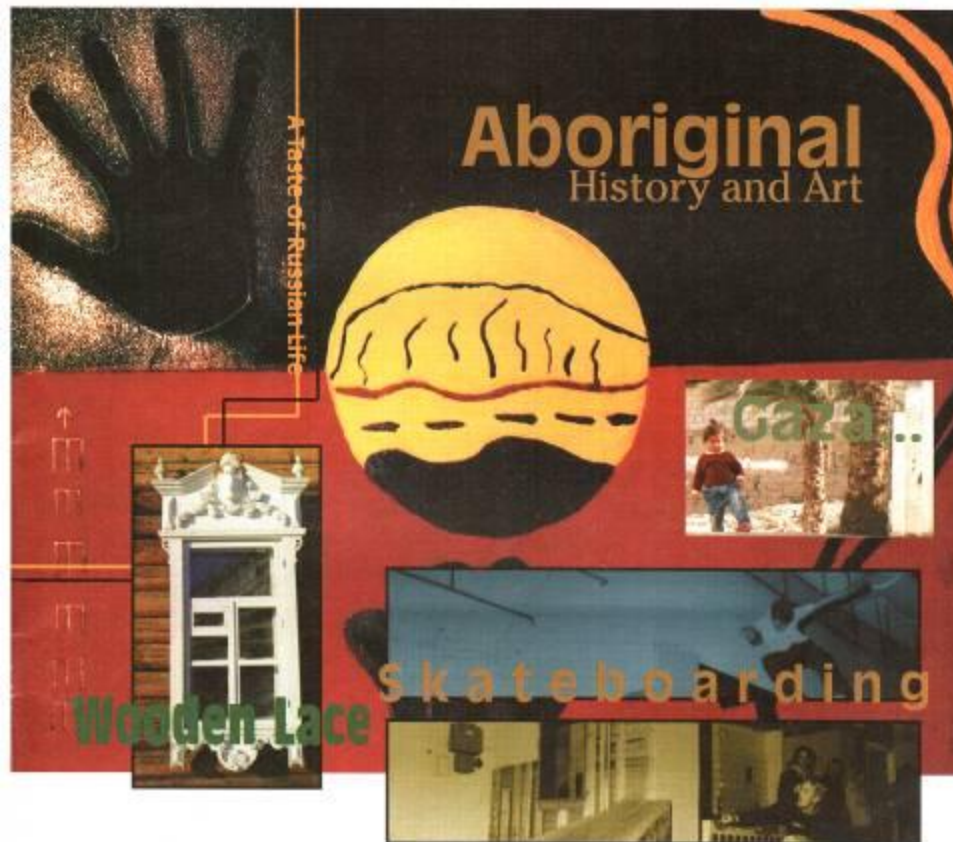

Cultural Treasures

I consider myself a happy person because I live in one of the most wonderful cities in the world. Every day, many tourists visit St. Petersburg—it's beautiful museums and cathedrals, palaces and galleries. From my point of view, my city is completely devoted to the arts. The State Russian Museum is the most excellent exhibition of works of art. More than that, the Russian Museum is situated in Fine Arts Square where you can also see the Maly Opera and Ballet Theatre, the Philharmonic, the Museum of Ethnography, the Comedy Theatre and a monument to Alexander Pushkin in the centre. You see how many places of interest there are in one square!

If you stop on the Palace Bridge and look around, you'll be fascinated by the splendour of colours the lemon yellow of the Admiralty, the bluish green of the

Winter Palace, and the warm red of the old university buildings. From here you can also see the Peter and Paul Fortress—my favourite place in St. Petersburg.

It was built as a fortress to defend the city from external enemies, but it was mostly used as a prison to keep the country safe from internal enemies. Actually, from the very first days of its existence, it served as a prison for political criminals. Now the fortress is a historical and architectural museum-monument where the last Russian tsar's remains were buried. That was a great event for the country and for the city too.

The Peter and Paul Fortress is situated on Zaischy Island, and every day at twelve o'clock we can hear the loud gun shots. In the fortress, there is the mint where the coins of the Russian empire were (and modern coins still are) produced.

In the middle of the fortress, you will find the Peter and Paul Cathedral with the Tsars' Vault near it. It was the highest building in St. Petersburg until the television tower was built. Every year, usually in summer, I visit Zaischy Island, walk along the alleys of the fortress surrounded by bastions, admiring the touch of history there.

During my short life I have visited many places in the world. I was born in Baku. I have often visited my relatives in Tbilisi. I have toured Latvia, Lithuania, The Ukraine and Belarus. I spent two summers visiting friends in Spain, but I can assure you that I have never seen a city like my St. Petersburg, with its magnificent architectural ensembles, granite embankments, museums and bridges, and its unique historical and cultural monuments.

A Magical World

St. Petersburg is always beautiful. Every season has its special clothing for the city, and a loving eye will always find something to admire. During the white summer nights it appears as if cloaked in some magic mist. And during the short winter days the city looks as if locked in ice because of numerous canals and rivers. Autumn is a show of extremely rich varieties of green, yellow, red. I like to walk in the parks and gardens of St. Petersburg and watch how nature blossoms in spring and how it "sleeps" in winter.

My favourite place in St. Petersburg is Summer Gardens. The architectural and

sculptural ensemble of it is one of the most treasured memorials of Russian culture of the early XVIII century. Crossing alleys, statues and fountains are the treasures of Summer Gardens. I enjoy looking at the statues of Nemesis, Geres, Night, etc. I imagine how, in the past, women in beautiful dresses promenaded with their companions in the alleys and, like me, they admired the quiet atmosphere, the rustle of the fallen leaves and the figures of the Gods and Goddesses which gently and silently smile at you.

The Moika side of the Gardens is fenced in by a cast-iron railing, ornamented with

bas-reliefs representing Medusa, Gorgona. In the Gardens, Peter's Summer Palace is hidden in the trees and bushes. Nowadays, it is a pleasant café open to everybody. I always imagine Summer Gardens as a beautiful magical world where in autumn the trees stand alive and the branches open the doors to welcome us inside.

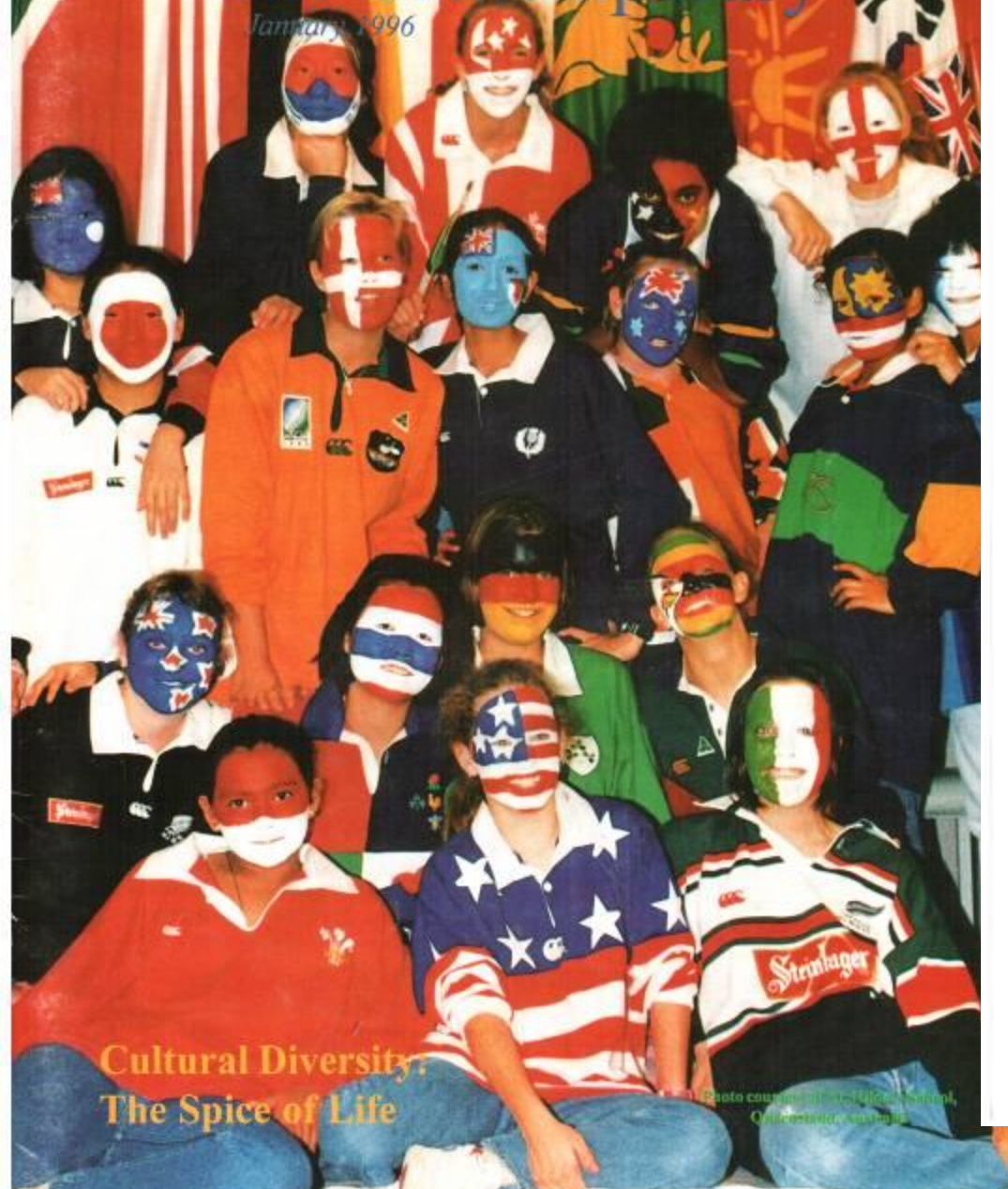

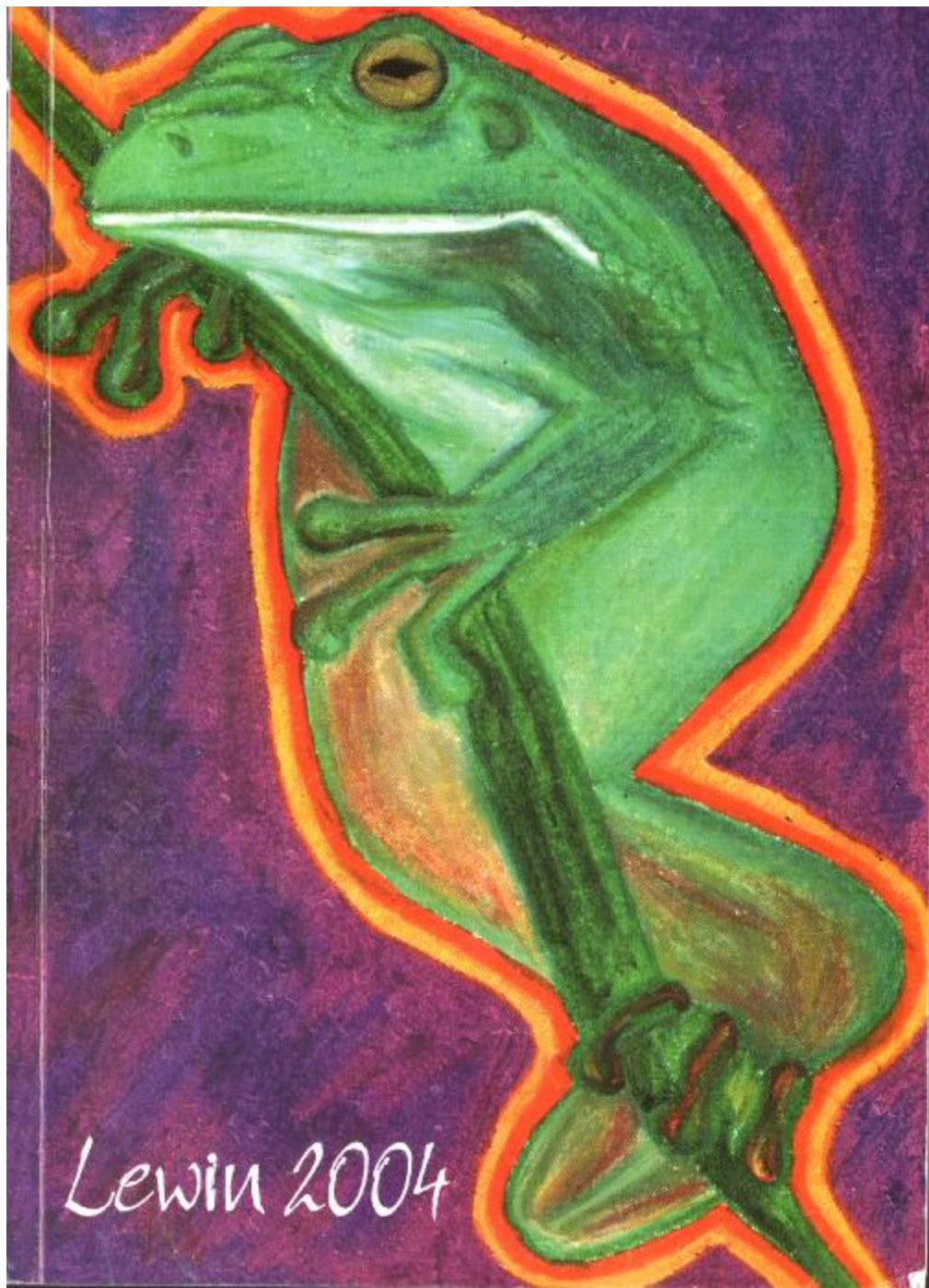
